Registration and Consent/Health Forms

Forms are available for printing on the band website (www.springhillband.org). Registration, Consent/Health Forms and deposit are due by May 7, 2010. Each student must have a Consent/ Health form on file before attending band camp.

Band Fee

The band fee for the 2010 school year is \$225. You must pay a \$100 deposit with your registration form, which is due by May 7, 2010. The remainder must be paid by August 2, 2010 (the first day of school). Please make your check payable to Spring Hill High School.

Any previous band member with an outstanding balance as of May 1, 2010, from the previous school year will not be allowed to participate in marching band.

Kroger Cards - (A great way to pay for trips and fees of the future.) If you use a Kroger Gift Card from the Spring Hill Band, 4% of what you load on your card goes to your student's account with the band. Gift cards may be used for groceries, at fuel centers, and with prescriptions. Cards are \$5 each and already have \$5 on them. These cards must be purchased from Mr. Jack to qualify for this program. You can load up to \$500 at a time on your card. Keep your card and keep reloading it for additional funds. Additional cards can be used by neighbors, friends, grandparents, etc., throughout the country (but the card must be purchased from Mr. Jack).

Auditions

Flags - will be held March 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12, 2010, from 3:00 to 6:00 pm in SHHS Band room.

Percussion - will be held April 20, 2010 (6:00 – 8:30 pm) and April 27, 2010 (6:00 - 8:00 pm) in SHHS Band room.

Marching Band is a Commitment

Each member is expected to keep his/her part of the commitment. When band members are missing from rehearsal and/or performances, the entire band suffers.

Band members are required to be at all performances and rehearsals.

It is also important you realize that a marching drill is written to include a specific number of people on the field. Once it is written, if a member drops out, there will always be an empty spot on the field where that person would have marched. *Please consider this carefully before committing to band.*

Commitment Includes:

- Attending every after school rehearsal
- Learning how to play your part (practicing at home)
- Not disrupting rehearsals
- Giving 100% in each rehearsal and performance
- Being present and on time at every performance

ALL REHEARSALS WILL TAKE PLACE AT SPRING HILL HIGH SCHOOL. WEAR COOL, LIGHT COLORED CLOTHES AND GOOD TENNIS SHOES THAT ARE SECURE TO YOUR FEET. **DO NOT WEAR SANDALS OR SHOES THAT HAVE AN OPEN HEEL.** BRING A WATER JUG WITH WATER, SUNSCREEN, HAT, YOUR INSTRUMENT, YOUR MUSIC, AND A PENCIL.

Summer Marching Camp

Camp is where we begin learning the drill and music for the upcoming marching season, so attendance is **mandatory**.

Freshman, New Marchers and Freshman Flags – July 14, 2010 (Wed) 8:00 am to 5:00 pm – Bring your instrument. Lunch will be provided by the SHHS Music Club.

Freshman, New Marchers, Freshman Flags, Second Year Flags, Sophomores, or Second Year Marchers – July 15, 2010 (Thurs) 8:00 am to 5:00 pm – Bring your instrument. Lunch will be provided by the SHHS Music Club.

Full Band and All Flags – Uniform Fitting Day - July 16, 2010 (Fri) 8:00 am to 5:00 pm 5PM – Bring your instrument and your lunch (a refrigerator will be available to store your lunch in). *See Note

Full Band and All Flags – July 19-23, 2010 (Mon– Fri) 8:00 am to 5:00 pm - Bring your instrument and your lunch (a refrigerator will be available to store your lunch in). *See Note

Note: If a student leaves SHHS to eat, the Maury County Board of Education, Spring Hill High School, and the Director of the band *will not* assume any responsibility for student actions or safety. All students are expected to return on time to rehearsals. Lunch breaks will last about 45 minutes.

Fall Schedule

Regular After School Rehearsals – for woodwinds, brass, percussion & flags beginning August 2, 2010, and continuing through Marching Season.

Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays – 3:00 pm – 5:30 pm

Football Games, Competitions, etc. – See Band Calendar and/or Schedule.

ITEMS YOU NEED TO PURCHASE:

Shoes: - \$40 – due on uniform fitting day, July 16, 2010 - (*Each member is required to have a pair of band uniform shoes. These can only be purchased through the Spring Hill High School Band. Shoes will be available to try on during the uniform fitting.*)

Black Socks: Each member is responsible for providing their own pair of calf-high black “show” socks (recommend purchasing two pair).

Instrument Accessories:

Wind Players – need to supply their own reeds and a lyre.

Percussionists – need a selection of sticks and mallets as determined at audition. Details given by the percussion instructor.
